A BILL TO AMEND CHAP-TER 1, TITLE 1 OF THE 1976 CODE, RELATING TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE GOVERNMENT GEN-ERALLY, BY ADDING AR-TICLE 5, TO ENACT THE

PERSONHOOD ACT SOUTH CAROLINA, TO ES-TABLISH THAT THE RIGHT TO LIFE FOR EACH BORN AND PREBORN HUMAN BEING VESTS AT FERTIL-IZATION AND THAT THE RIGHTS OF DUE PROCESS AND EQUAL PROTECTION, GUARANTEED BY ARTICLE We must also request Sen. Luke I, SECTION 3 OF THE CON-STITUTION OF THIS STATE, VEST AT FERTILIZATION FOR EACH BORN AND PRE-BORN HUMAN BEING.
