The <u>SC House</u> and the <u>SC Senate</u> each return to the State House in Columbia for special session on Wednesday, May 28 to take up state budget matters.

Since the Regular Session ended on May 8, the subject matter of what the SC Legislature may take up is defined in what is known as the Sine Die Resolution (tellingly, <u>S.292</u> was passed early in the regular Session, back in March - in other words, the "fix" was in early in the Session for the fake "pro-life" [sic] "Republican" House and Senate Leadership to punt on stopping the murder of children in the womb during 2025).

Wisely, prudently, and dutifully, the SC House Freedom Caucus attempted to amend the Sine Die Resolution before the Regular Session ended, to include allowing the SC Legislature to take up during special session, "Bills relating to protection of human rights of preborn people." This admirable effort took place on May 8 (House Journal) when Rep. Pace (Chairman of the SC House Freedom Caucus) offered as an amendment to the Sine Die Resolution, a concurrent resolution H.4549.

(No similar effort is known to have been attempted in the toxic compromise culture of the fake "pro-life" [sic] "Republican" (70%+) Super-Majority SC Senate.)

Here is Rep. Pace's proposed pro-life amendment on May 8 to the Sine Die Resolution and the ensuing Roll Call vote to kill it by the fake "pro-life" [sic] (70%+) "Republican" Super-Majority House of Representatives (from the May 8 House Journal):

<u>H.4549</u> -- ORDERED COMMITTED TO COMMITTEE ON RULES [in other words, the Pace amendment was buried, killed]

The following was introduced:

H. 4549 (Word version) -- Rep. Pace: A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION TO PROVIDE THAT IN ADDITION TO THE MATTERS WHICH MAY BE CONSIDERED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AFTER MAY 8, 2025, PURSUANT TO THE SINE DIE RESOLUTION FOR THE 2025 LEGISLATIVE SESSION AS PASSED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, BILLS RELATING TO PROTECTION OF HUMAN RIGHTS OF PREBORN PEOPLE ALSO MAY BE INTRODUCED, RECEIVED, AND CONSIDERED BY EACH BODY OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY PRIOR TO SINE DIE ADJOURNMENT INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, CONCURRENCE, NONCONCURRENCE, AND APPOINTMENT OF CONFEREES; RECEIPT, CONSIDERATION, AND DISPOSITION OF CONFERENCE AND FREE CONFERENCE REPORTS; AND RECEIPT, CONSIDERATION, AND DISPOSITION OF ANY VETOES, IF APPLICABLE.

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring:

That in addition to matters which may be considered by the General Assembly after May 8, 2025, pursuant to the Sine Die Resolution for the 2025 Legislative Session as passed by the General Assembly,

the following matters may be introduced, received, and considered by each body of the General Assembly prior to Sine Die Adjournment including, but not limited to, concurrence, nonconcurrence, and appointment of conferees; receipt, consideration, and disposition of conference and free conference reports; and receipt, consideration, and disposition of any vetoes, if applicable:

(1) Bills relating to protection of human rights of preborn people. [emphasis added]

Rep. <u>BRITTAIN</u> moved to **[kill Rep. Pace's amendment]** commit the Concurrent Resolution to the Committee on Rules.

Rep. MAGNUSON demanded the yeas and nays which were taken, resulting as follows:
