PUBLIC REDISCLSOURE OF PAGES 8, 9 & 10 OF PRESENTENCE INVESTIGATION REPORT
(THE DEFENDANT'S CRIMINAL HISTORY)**

NOW COMES *pro se* Defendant Steven Clark Lefemine, and respectfully moves the Court for consent of the sentencing judge to allow *pro se* defendant's public redisclosure of pages 8, 9 & 10 (copy/scan) of the presentence investigation report (The Defendant's Criminal History), in accordance with the statement in smaller font at the bottom of page 4 of the July 2, 2024 presentence investigation report beginning, "***Restrictions on Use and Redisclosure of Presentence Report.***"

This information concerning **Date of Arrest**, **Conviction/Court**, and **Date Sentence Imposed/Disposition** is presumably already publicly available information, and includes eight convictions prior to the instant offense of conviction. The eighth conviction of those listed occurred in March 2003.

It is noted that in the Government's Sentencing Memorandum (ECF No. 131, filed 7/12/2024), in paragraph 1. **The history and characteristics of the defendant**, in describing the Defendant's prior convictions, the Government makes no mention whatsoever that the most recent prior conviction of those listed in the presentence investigation report occurred over 21 years ago. Neither did the prosecutor state such in open court during the Sentencing Hearing on July 31, 2024.
